



## INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

The internal assessment provides a feedback on teaching learning process. The feedback after being analyzed is passed on to the concerned student for implementation and subsequent improvement.

As a part of concurrent evaluation, the learners shall be evaluated on a continuous basis by the Institute to ensure that student learning takes place in a graded manner.

Internal assessment components are designed in such a way that the faculty can monitor the student learning & development and intervene wherever required. The faculty shares the outcome of each internal evaluation component with the students, soon after the evaluation, and guide the students for betterment

Individual faculty member has a flexibility to design the internal assessment components in a manner so as to give a balanced assessment of student capabilities across Knowledge, Skills & Attitude dimensions based on variety of assessment tools.
